

Pre-participation Physical Exam (PPE) and Athletic Participation Forms

Sacred Heart Cathedral Prep is pleased to announce the use of Appryse Athletic Participation Forms Registration for the 2017-18 school year.

What is Appryse?

Appryse is a web-based replacement to the paper-based Athletic Participation Forms system previously used to track medical history, contact information, and Pre-participation Physical Exam (PPE) forms. Parents are able to enter all information online including uploading the PPE form directly to Appryse. It also allows you to electronically submit Emergency Information and electronically sign the following required forms: Policies and Procedures, Awareness of Injury Risk and Consent to Treat, Concussion Parent/Athlete Information, Awareness of Sports Injury Risk, and Sudden Cardiac Arrest Information. We feel it will make this year much easier for parents, coaches, and most importantly, increase the safety of our students.

Enrolling in Appryse

All incoming freshman are required to enroll in Appryse, regardless of whether a student intends to join an athletic team.

Information regarding your son or daughter's medical history should be updated throughout the year as needed.

Important notes before registering

- Parents need to enroll their child onto Appryse – there is information for both parent and student to review and acknowledge via electronic signature.
- You only need to enroll once per school year.
- Enroll using a desktop computer/laptop or tablet – you may NOT use a mobile phone.
- Enrolling in Appryse will allow you to download a blank 2017-18 SHC Pre-participation Physical Exam (PPE) form, which will include your child's name and a barcode. Please have your physician complete this form.
- The parent should scan and upload the single page Appryse SHC PPE form directly to Appryse.
- 10th-12th grade students that have a current PPE on file do not need to upload one at this time. Once it expires, you will need to upload a current form onto Appryse.
- Do NOT upload or fax a different physical form, as this will not be recognized by the Appryse system will reject it.
- Do not include attachments such as immunization forms.
- We will NOT accept hard copies of PPE forms.
- Please make sure the Appryse SHC PPE form is properly completed - signed, dated, stamped or it will not be accepted.
- Only forms completed by an MD or DO will be accepted. We will not accept forms completed by other health care professionals such as registered nurses (RN), nurse practitioners (NP), physician assistants (PA), and chiropractors (DC).
